

MUCHEA SHEEP REPORT 19th FEBRUARY 2019

Muchea reports a total yarding of 11,618 sheep and lambs with Landmark offering 5,282. The yarding consisted of mainly lambs and the mutton being good with heavy weights penned and good trade to boning types penned.

Heavy crossbred lambs remained firm with most sales from \$135 - \$153. Air freight wether lambs had an increase of \$5 - \$8 due to the current LSS order. Store lambs struggled due to seasonal conditions and dropped \$10.

Heavy ewe mutton remained firm ranging from \$110 - \$130. Trade and boning ewes had a decrease in price due to short demand ranging from \$45 - \$85. Rams remained firm.
