

## MUCHEA VEAL REPORT 27th July 2020

Muchea agents yarded a total of 236 calves with Nutrien selling a total of 95 of them. Demand on pastoral bred cattle slightly dropped today as was the trend from the previous sale. There was equal competition on the local type calves from graziers and eastern states buyers.

Local bull calves sold to strong competition from graziers and exporters with the top line selling to \$525. Pastoral bulls were also in demand up to \$525.

Pastoral bred heifers varied in price according to quality this week with the tops selling to \$535 to a local butcher.
