Today Muchea agents yarded a total of 287 calves with Nutrien yarding 120 of them. Again, competition was strong from the eastern states graziers and local demand was increased again. Butchers were again chancing calves that were suitable for kill. Slaughter condition animals jumped \$80-\$120.

Local Bulls calves were in short supply and were older types. These were back in value and the tops sold to \$450. Pastoral Bulls sold to strong grazer demand up to \$450 also.

Local heifers again jumped in value with the tops selling to \$555 and the slaughter pastoral heifers up to \$625.
