## MUCHEA CATTLE REPORT 17th August 2020

Nutrien Livestock reports 1150 cattle sold at Muchea on Monday August 17th with 33 of these in the calf sale. An excellent run of heavy pastoral steers saw values peak at 298c/kg. Pastoral heifers over 400kg were also keenly sought and sold to $326 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$. The very few local trade steers and heifers available sold strongly to firmer rates. Medium and light pastoral heifers remained firm.
Good supplies of heavy bulls saw prices slightly higher, bulls suitable for live export or to feed generally were equal, however lightweights lifted $5-8 \mathrm{c} / \mathrm{kg}$. A good presentation of cows, which were mainly pastoral, met very strong competition causing values to lift 40c/kg across most categories.
