

MUCHEA VEAL REPORT 24th August 2020

Today Muchea agents yarded a total of 188 calves with 166 of them being sold by Nutrien Livestock. Demand was up significantly on all categories today.

The majority of the yarding was pastoral bred cattle with a small percentage being local calves.

Pastoral bulls sold to strong demand at a top of \$645 to a live exporter. Both main exporters were active on the heavier bulls. Graziers were very competitive on the light end also.

Pastoral heifers also sold to increased demand from all buyers. A pen of shorthorn heifers sold up to \$470 to a local butcher.

Pastoral steers were also presented for sale this week with strong eastern states demand selling up to \$500.
