

MUCHEA VEAL REPORT 26th OCTOBER 2020

Today, Muchea agents yarded a total of 475 vealers with Nutrien selling 364 of them. Demand went to another level today with all classes of buyers being very very active.

Pastoral bulls sold to strong grazier demand from both the eastern states and WA graziers. Local bull calves also increased in value and topped out at \$895.

Local steers were in supply today and sold up to a top of \$900.

Locally bred heifers sold to strong grazier demand with little impact from WA graziers. These heifers sold to \$800.

Pastoral heifers followed the last weeks trend on pastoral heifers and bounced upwards dramatically to a top of \$480.
