

MUCHEA VEAL REPORT 2nd NOVEMBER 2020

Today, Muchea agents yarded a total of 226 vealers with Nutrien selling 97 of them. Demand continued to grow today to see record prices on locally bred cattle.

Pastoral bulls sold to strong grazier and export demand with the majority of the bulls going to eastern states buyers. The top pen of pastoral bulls sold to \$690. Local bull calves also increased in value and topped out at \$875.

Local steers were in supply today and sold up to a top of \$955.

Locally bred heifers sold to strong grazier demand across the board. These heifers sold to \$945.

Pastoral heifers sold again to strong grazier demand from both WA and eastern states graziers.
