

### **MUCHEA VEAL REPORT 7th December 2020**

Today Muchea agents yarded a total of 440 calves with Nutrien selling 331 of them. The local calves penned had more weight and quality compared to previous weeks and the pastoral types were lighter in condition.

Local Angus steers were the highlight of the calf sale with the top Angus steer calves selling to \$1115 and the Charolais pen selling to \$1135. Backgrounders from WA were very active on these types.

Local type heifers were also in demand from graziers and butchers with a pen of Charolais heifers selling to \$925

Pastoral bull calves were in short supply and sold to \$625 to eastern states orders. Pastoral heifers were in strong supply and lacked condition on bigger lines. The best pen of heifers sold to \$430.
