Today Muchea agents yarded a total of 1448 head with 76 of them sold in the calf pens. A total of 19 were sold by Nutrien.

The general numbers lifted dramatically today and demand was back up with eastern states graziers back in the market.

Local bull calves climbed in value and sold up to \$1000 for a pen of 2 Murray Grey Bulls.

Local steer calves sold to a high of \$910 for a pen of 2 Angus steers.

Local heifer calves also sold to stronger demand with a pen of Angus heifers selling to \$900.
