## Market Comment:

A larger yarding than usual this week with some big drafts of top quality lamb and mutton. 12786 head offered with a breakdown of approx 5987 lambs and 4524 mutton.

The heavy lamb market remained strong with local processor support with the majority selling at \$155 to \$165 topping out at \$177. genuine trade lamb were buoyed slightly by increased feeder competition with the majority selling at better rates of \$140 to \$155 per head while airfreight types were also slightly dearer at rates of \$138 to \$145 with stores also slightly dearer the majority at \$105 to \$130 to a low of \$70.

The Ewe mutton market remained very similar to last week wioth big draft offered attracting strong support from local processors and graziers on selected types. The heavy ewe mutton remains strong selling at rates of \$155 to \$175 while the genuine trade types also remained similar selling at \$120 to \$150. Boners eased slightly despite grazier support with the majority selling at \$85 to \$115 with light types selling easier also at rates of \$40 to \$82 per head.

Merino Lambs remain very similar with support from feeders and graziers, merino wether lambs sold at rates of \$125 to \$150 for the better trade type while the store grades were very similar to slightly stronger at rates of \$80 to \$130.
