## **Market Comment:**

Agents Yarded 12596 sheep this week, an increase of 457 head. Nutrien Accounting for 8024 Head. Yarding was dominated by 6063 lambs in store to trade with very few heavy slaughter types available. 4042 mutton were yarded with most drafts being aged mutton and 20 - 28kg dressed category.

Heavy lambs over 26kg dressed sold \$170 - \$185. Trade lambs very solid at rates \$140 - \$177. Airfreight lambs were highly sort after by feed lotters, butchers and live exporters. Selling up to \$10 dearer at rates \$110 - \$145.

Heavy ewe mutton sold at similar rates to last week with 3 buyers active. \$150 - \$180 while trade weight mutton sold under the full range of buyer activity, pushing rates up by \$10 to sell \$110 - \$150. Any younger ewes sold to graziers regardless of condition at rates \$120 - \$150. Plain score 1 ewes sold consistently at rates of \$60 - \$120.

Merino wethers in score 3+ sold under stronger competition from live exporters and butchers selling from \$140 - \$200 while lighter weights sold to butcher and graziers at rates \$105 -\$140.

Heavy rams 80kg liveweight plus sold \$100 - \$130. Plainer rams \$60 - \$90 aged score 1 rams plus heavy horn sold \$10 - \$40.
