Market Comment:

Numbers increased slightly this week with agents yarding 10905 in total with Nutrien Accounting for 4955 Head, the yarding was comprised of 1558 Ewe Mutton with lambs making up the majority yet again with 7709 head offered with some great trade lambs up the front.

The prime lamb market remains strong with local processors continuing to support the sale pushed by feeders and agents on the lighter end, The majority of Heavy lambs sold at rates of \$175 to \$190 with Nutriens top draft making \$191 for 33 Crossbred Lambs sold on behalf of GI & PJ Jolly from Goomarin. Genuine trade types strengthened upto \$5 per head supported by feeders with the majority selling at rates of \$145 to \$170 while the biggest lift in the market came on the airfreight feeder types lifting upto \$10 per head with the majority making \$105 to \$135 per head.

The ewe mutton numbers remain similar to last week with some brilliant types offered in large drafts, the highlight of the mutton yarding was a draft of 145 SAMM Cross ewes selling to local processors for \$228 per head sold on behalf of "Fairway" of Morawa. The majority of heavy mutton remained similar to last week selling at rates of \$160 to \$185, genuine trade types strenghtened somewhat with the majority selling at rates of \$135 to \$155, boner mutton also saw a slight increase in competition selling at rates of \$90 to \$125 per head.

The wether lambs offered attracted strong agent and feeder competition yet again with bigger drafts attracting a premium. The majority of feeder and airfreight merino wethers sold at rates of \$125 to \$150 per head with genuine store types selling at rates of \$95 to \$120 per head with very strong Nutrien agent support.
