The usual processor buyers were in attendance, however there was a lack of urgency in the bidding and a general fall of \$5 to \$10 was evident. The quality remained mixed, with well finished heavy and trade lambs in better supply.

In the lamb market. Light 0 to 12kg lambs sold to a smaller number of restockers at rates \$15 easier. The ewe lambs sold from \$44 to \$867 the wether lambs from \$60 to \$74. The 13 to 16kg range received reduced demand and sold from \$68 to \$125, down \$10/head, at 730c/kg cwt. The 17 to 20kg range also eased \$5 to \$10 and sold from \$120 to \$148 at again near 730c/kg cwt. The 21 to 22kg range sold from \$145 to \$172 at near 730c/kg cwt to be \$5 easier, with larger lines down \$10. The prime lambs 23 to 24kg sold from \$170 to \$191/head to remain firm. Heavier lambs eased \$5 to \$10 and sold from \$197 to \$206.

The ram lamb supply saw the best of the heaviest at \$120 to \$154/head, down \$20 on a poorer selection. Hoggets were firm and the heaviest 25kg plus sold from \$149 to \$194/head.

The ewe mutton yarding included a mix of weights and grades, with a fall of \$10 on extra heavy weights. Medium weight boners 20 to 24kgs made from \$100 to \$145/head at near 585c/kg. The prime trade weight ewes 25 to 30kgs sold from \$150 to \$181, at 600c/kgcwt. The better quality heavy 30kgs plus sold from \$180 to \$187, down \$10/head. The best heavy wethers received 545c/kg cwt and sold from \$180 to \$200, firm with very few penned.
