## **Market Comment:**

Numbers eased this week with agents yarding 13633 in total with Nutrien Accounting for 5721 Head, the yarding was comprised of 2439 Ewe Mutton with lambs accounting for 9861 head of the offering with several good drafts up the front.

The overall quality of this week lamb yarding was of a lessor quality on last week. The Heavy prime lamb market remains very similar with the majority of better drafts selling at rates of \$175 to \$185 with Nutriens top draft making \$204 for 19 Crossbred Lambs sold on behalf of DA & PA Bantock from Mogumber.

Genuine trade types eased approx \$5 per head with the majority selling at rates of \$145 to \$170. The airfreight / feeder types took the biggest slide with the majority of drafts \$10 to \$15 easier due to a lack of competition,

the majority selling at rates of \$102 to \$130 with genuine store types also selling at easier rates of \$75 to \$100 to a low of \$45.

The ewe mutton numbers eased significantly this week but fortunately the quality remains along with the market. The majority of heavy mutton remained similar to last week selling at rates of \$160 to \$185 topping out at \$185 for a line of 34 Merino Ewes sold on behalf of D & R Barnett & JNB Farms Pty Ltd,

genuine trade types remain similar with the majority selling at rates of \$135 to \$155, boner mutton also saw no change selling at rates of \$95 to \$130 per head. light boners sold at rates of \$40 to \$85.

The wether lambs offered attracted agent interest again with bigger drafts of stores more sought after however the majority eased slightly in value selling at rates of \$85 to \$135 per head with the trade types remaining similar selling at rates of \$140 to \$160 per head.
