## Market Comment:

Numbers eased significantly this week with agents yarding 5865 Head with the majority of the offering being Merino Lambs, quality throughout the yarding

There were very few heavy weight and finished trade lamb drafts offered this week despite this the Heavy prime lamb market remains firm with the majority of drafts selling at rates of \$175 to \$185 with the trade types remaining firm at \$145 to \$170 per head with store grades also remaining similar selling at rates of \$95 to \$130 down to a low of \$40 per head

Our top pen of lambs this week made \$175 for 52 crossbred lambs offered on behalf of the Lambert Investment trust, Bakers hill.

The ewe mutton numbers eased significantly this week with only 763 head yarded.

The heavy grades remained similar to last week selling at rates of \$160 to \$185.

Genuine trades types also remained firm with most selling at \$135 to \$155

boner mutton also saw no change selling at rates of \$95 to \$130 per head. light boners sold at rates of \$40 to \$85.

Merino wether lambs once again attracted grazier and agent interest with several drafts of store grades offered with the majority slightly dearer selling at rates of \$88 to \$135 with any trade merino lambs being sold to the trade at \$140 to \$155 per head.

Also included in this week were two drafts of well bred young Goats, the wethers made \$115 with similar sized billys sold at \$110
