## Market Comment:

A very small offering again this week with agents yarding 4069 head with some stock being pulled late from the sale due to the wether events in the mid west.

Despite the small offering there were some great quality lambs offered with the sale highlight being a pen of 60 poll dorset cross lambs offered on behalf of Spreadalong farms out of Bindi Bindi making \$210 per head with the remaining heavy weights selling at rates of \$185 to \$205 finishing stronger than last week by approximately \$10.

Lambs in the trade weight category sold at rates of \$155 to \$175 to be \$5/8 dearer than last week with the limited offering of airfreight/feeder also seeing an increase with most pens selling for \$120 to \$140 per head with genuine stores selling at rates of \$60 to \$110 to also finish slightly stronger.

There were very few pens of Ewe Mutton offered making for a slightly erratic market with lack of numbers for buyers to compete on, despite this the market strengthened significantly on last week with the heavy grades selling at rates of \$160 to \$200 per head to be approx \$5 dearer.

The few Genuine trades also sold stronger at \$135 to \$155 per head with a couple of pens of boners making \$85 to \$105 per head to remain very similar to last week.

Nutrien's top pen of ewe mutton were 100 dorpers ewes sold on behalf of Dawson 17 Pty Ltd of Toodyay for \$200 per head.
