Market Comment:

A smaller yarding this week in Muchea, in total agents yarded 14578 head with Nutrien agents offering 7330 of the total. The majority of the yarding was made up of lambs with 9611 head and 3686 ewe mutton offered.

There were some great pens of lambs up the front with the top price pen of 6 crossbred lambs selling at \$196 per head on behalf of River Road Trees. The remaining heavy weights selling very similar to last week at \$180 to \$195 per head.

Lambs in the trade weight category remain stable selling at rates of \$155 to \$175 while the light trade took a slight kick to sell at rates of \$140 to \$165 per head. the Airfreight / Feeder types remain strong with good local competition selling at rates of \$125 to \$145 with genuine stores enjoying increased competition strengthening to sell at rates of \$65 to \$125 competed on by agents and graziers.

There were some good large drafts of Ewe Mutton offered in the outside pens. The Heavy ewe mutton sold at rates of \$160 to \$210 per head very similar to last week while Genuine trade types eased slightly selling at \$130 to \$145 per head light trade and boners both followed and eased slightly.

Nutrien's top pen of ewe mutton were 7 Poll Dorset ewes sold on behalf of River Road Trees for \$214 per head.

The wether lambs market even with large drafts offered remains similar with most heavy drafts selling to processors at rates of \$155 to \$175 per head with the airfreight / feeder types selling similar to feeders and agents at rates of \$125 to \$135. Stores also remain unchanged selling at rates of \$65 to \$125 per head.
