Numbers eased by 4500 with only 6988 head penned. The quality eased slightly however the lack of numbers drove values on trade lambs up by \$5 to \$10 and light store lambs up \$10 to \$20. Ram lambs gained \$15 a head and the better mutton was nearer \$20 dearer.

In the lamb market, the light 0 to 12kg lambs sold to restockers at rates \$7 dearer than last week. They sold from \$30 to \$78. The 13 to 16kg range to graziers gained \$20 and sold from \$70 to \$130. The 17 to 20kg range gained \$10 and sold from \$125 to \$149 at rates averaging 780c/kg cwt. The 21 to 22kg range sold to the trade and feedlots from \$144 to \$178/head, up \$8 at near 760c/kg cwt. The prime lambs 23kg plus, were of outstanding quality and sold from \$177 to \$230/head, up by \$4 head at near 810c/kg cwt and were the pick of the lambs yarded.

The ram lamb supply improved, with the better heavier types at \$125 to \$175 head, up \$15. Best heavy hoggets sold from \$143 to \$185, firm at near 630c/kg cwt.

The ewe mutton yarding included a mix of weights and grades, with rates \$18 to \$20 dearer on trade and heavy weights. The medium weight boners 22 to 24kgs sold from \$110 to \$146/head at near 570c/kg cwt. The prime trade weight ewes 25 to 30kgs sold from \$150 to \$207, at 650c/kg cwt. The better quality heavy 30kgs plus sold at \$180 to \$224 at 620c/kg cwt. Prime heavy wethers sold from \$150 to \$200, firm.

Old rams remained firm and sold from \$120 to \$150 for heavy weights over 30 kg cwt.
