## Market Comment:

Agents Yarded 6988 head this week with yarding made up of 4658 Lambs and 1420 ewe mutton with a significant improvement in quality throughout.

Nutriens top price lambs were a pen of 36 white suffolk cross lambs, that sold for \$230 per head on behalf of B & M Stokes & Sons. The remaining heavy weights sold at stronger rates of \$190 to \$210 per head.

Lambs in the trade weight category also sold slightly dearer at \$165 to \$180 while the light weights sold very similar to last week with the majority selling at \$140 to \$165 per head. The Airfreight / Feeder also remain similar at rates of \$115 to \$135 with genuine stores to a low of \$60

There were some brilliant ewe mutton offered this week with the top draft of 100 Merino ewes offered on behalf of ER & J Button topping our market at \$224 per head, the remaining heavy ewe mutton sold dearer at rates of \$170 to \$215 per head, Genuine trade types also rebounded selling at \$140 to \$165 per head while light trade and boners sold at similar rates of \$65 to \$130 per head.

There were very few good quality store wethers available, competition came from Agents and graziers with the majority selling similar. Better store types sold at rates of \$125 to \$145 per head, lighter second drafts sold at \$85 to \$115.
