Market Comment:

The Muchea offering this week was a total of 7344 head with Nutrien accounting for 3072 head of the total. The yarding was comprised of 6597 Lambs and 451 ewe mutton.

The few heavy weight lambs sold at rates of \$190 to \$210 per head, selling very similar to last week.

Lambs in the trade weight category also stayed strong selling at rates of \$165 to \$180 with the light trade selling at \$155 to \$175 per head to remain similar. The Airfreight / Feeder types took a rise due to feeder demand selling \$10 dearer at rates of \$140 to \$165 with genuine stores also taking a rise selling for \$80 to \$135 per head.

There were very few ewe mutton offered yet again this week with the handful of heavy ewe mutton selling very similar at rates of \$170 to \$230 per head, genuine trade types sold slightly dearer at rates of \$145 to \$170 per head while light trade and boners sold similar at rates of \$85 to \$130 per head.

There were several large drafts of quality store wether lambs available, competition came from Agents buying on behalf of graziers with better store types selling dearer at \$135 to \$155 per head, lighter second drafts also took a rise selling at \$115 to \$130 per head.
