

## Detailed Saleyard Report - Sheep and Lamb

Numbers eased by 625 with 6,675 head penned. It was a reduced quality yarding as we come to the tail end of the lamb season. Store lambs to feedlots were \$5 to \$10/head easier, not surprising with new season lambs envisaged to be only a month away from the market. The light trade and trade lambs eased \$5, while heavy lambs were the pick of the yarding and gained \$10, selling to a top price of \$217/head. Heavy hoggets were up \$20, making \$212, with heavy ewe mutton up \$5, selling to a top of \$228/head. The best heavy wethers obtained the premium price of \$240/head.

In the lamb market, the light weight 0 to 12kg lambs sold to graziers from \$87 to \$90/head. The 13 to 16kg range of lambs to graziers sold from \$80 to \$137, down \$10/head. Lambs weighing 17 to 20kg sold \$5 to \$10 easier, to make from \$124 to \$159/head and average 750c to 800c/kg cwt. The 21 to 22kg range sold to the trade and feedlots from \$150 to \$182, down \$5/head at near 775c/kg cwt. The prime lambs weighing 23kg plus gained \$10 and sold from \$174 to \$217/head to average 785c/kg cwt.

Heavy ram lambs fell \$10 and sold from \$162 to \$175/head, averaging 680c/kg cwt. The best heavy hoggets gained \$20 while the better heavier types made from \$150 to \$212/head, or close to 660c/kg cwt.

The ewe mutton yarding included a mix of weights and grades, with prices generally firm on the under 25kg range. The medium weight boners weighing 23 to 24kg sold from \$130 to \$140/head at 565c/kg. The prime trade weight ewes weighing 25 to 30kg sold from \$150 to \$218/head, at 660c/kg cwt to remain firm. The better quality heavy mutton types sold from \$200 to \$228, up \$5/head to average 615c/kg cwt. The very few prime heavy wethers sold from \$209 to \$240 and medium weight 25 to 30kg wethers made from \$169 to \$205, up \$15/head on a better selection.
