## **Market Comment:**

The Muchea offering this week had a total of 5533 head with Nutrien accounting for 2562 head which was appox 47% of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised of 4164 Lambs and 793 ewe mutton.

The heavy weight lambs sold at rates of \$190 to \$220 per head, with little to no change on last week,

Lambs in the trade weight category also stayed strong selling at rates of \$165 to \$180 with the light trade selling at \$155 to \$175 per head. The Airfreight / Feeder types eased approx \$5 per head mostly due to a volume feeder buyer being absent from the market, most pens sold at rates of \$130 to \$148 per head with genuine stores selling for \$70 to \$125 per head.

The few ewe mutton offered sold well with returns of \$170 to \$220 per head. Genuine trade types sold strong yet again at rates of \$145 to \$170 per head with light trade and boner mutton remaining firm on last week selling at rates of \$85 to \$130 per head.

There were only a couple of lines of better store wether lambs available making it difficult to quote the market, the majority of what was offered sold at \$130 to \$155 per head to agents buying on behalf of graziers, lighter second drafts sold at rates of \$105 to \$120 per head down to a low of \$70 for very small frame lighter types.
