## **Market Comment:**

The muchea offering this week had a total of 5797 head with quality significantly better than the last few weeks, Nutrien accounted for 3109 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised of 2900 Lambs, 77 sucker lambs and 2243 ewe mutton.

The heavy weight lambs sold at rates of \$180 to \$220 per head, to remain similar. Our top pen sold at \$229 in the skin.

Lambs in the trade weight category also remained the same selling at rates of \$165 to \$175 with the light trade selling at \$150 to \$160 per head. The Airfreight / Feeder types remained similar with most pens selling at rates of \$125 to \$140 per head with genuine stores selling for \$60 to \$115 per head.

The there were some brilliant ewe mutton offered with eastern wheatbelt types leading the market yet again selling at a high of \$232 in the wool, the majority sold at \$175 to \$220 per head to be stronger by \$3/4, Genuine trade types sold strong yet again with another slight increase in rates selling at \$145 to \$172 per head with light trade and boner mutton remaining unchanged at rates of \$85 to \$130 per head.

There were several good lines of better store wether lambs attracting the attention of graziers and agents selling at \$125 to \$145 per head which was to remain even on last week, lighter second drafts sold at rates of \$90 to \$110 per head down to a low of \$50 for very small frame lighter types.
