Market Comment:

The very small offering at Muchea this week had a total of 4101 head with Nutrien accounting for 1817 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised of 2907 Lambs, 283 sucker lambs and 555 ewe mutton.

The few heavy weight lambs offered sold at rates of \$180 to \$210 per head, remaining similar.

Lambs in the trade weight category also remained simialr selling at rates of \$160 to \$175 with the light trade selling at \$150 to \$160 per head. The Airfreight / Feeder types lifted slightly with most pens selling at rates of \$125 to \$145 per head with genuine stores selling for \$65 to \$120 per head finishing slightly dearer.

The there were very few ewe mutton offered but what was available was of a high quality. The majority sold at \$175 to \$205 per head. Genuine trade types sold strong yet again at rates of \$145 to \$175 per head with the sparse light trade and boner mutton selling at rates of \$85 to \$130 per head.

The few store wether lambs attracted the attention of graziers and agents again selling at \$125 to \$145 per head which was similar to last week, lighter second drafts sold at rates of \$90 to \$110 per head down to a low of \$50 for very small frame lighter types.
