

MUCHEA VEAL REPORT 9th August 2021

Today Muchea agents yarded a total of 64 calves with Nutrien Livestock selling 55 of them.

Numbers again were equal this week. Demand from all sectors increased dramatically.

Local bull calves met with solid grazier demand and made up to \$905 whilst the pastoral run of bulls sold with equal demand making \$920.

There was a run of locally bred steers that presented well and met with fierce competition, the best pen selling up to \$915.

The heifer run also met with strong support with the best local heifers making \$740 and a line of Ethel Creek heifers making \$850 under strong competition.
