## Market Comment:

The very small offering at Muchea this week had a total of 6828 head with Nutrien accounting for 3557 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised of 3310 Lambs, 314 sucker lambs and 2537 ewe mutton.

The few heavy weight lambs offered sold at rates of \$178 to \$200 per head easing slightly. Lambs in the trade weight category also eased selling at rates of \$160 to \$170 with the light trade selling at \$150 to \$160 per head. The Airfreight / Feeder types lifted slightly with most pens selling dearer at rates of \$130 to \$150 per head with genuine stores selling for \$65 to \$125 per head finishing slightly dearer.

There were some good drafts of ewe mutton offered this week. The majority sold at \$175 to \$215 per head to a top of \$240 wooly. Genuine trade types sold strong yet again at rates of \$145 to \$175 per head with the sparse light trade and boner mutton selling at rates of \$75 to \$125 per head.

The few store wether lambs attracted the attention of graziers and agents again selling at \$125 to \$145 per head which was similar to last week, lighter second drafts sold at rates of \$90 to \$110 per head down to a low of \$50 for very small frame lighter types.
