## Market Comment:

The similar offering to last week at Muchea had a total of 7559 head with Nutrien accounting for 3095 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised of 2481 Lambs, 1432 sucker lambs and 2956 ewe mutton.

Heavy weight old seasons lambs sold at slightly easier rates of \$175 to \$192 per head with New seasons heavy lambs firm at \$185 to \$192.

Old seasons trade weight lambs also eased slightly selling at rates of \$155 to \$172 with the trade suckers selling at \$175 to \$183 per head. Old Seasons light trade sold at \$140 to \$152 per head, light trade suckers sold at \$150 to \$170. The Airfreight / Feeder types sold at rates of \$130 to \$150 per head with feeder suckers selling at \$110 to \$140. Old seasons genuine stores selling for \$60 to \$115 with new seasons store selling at rates of \$65 to \$105

There were some good drafts of ewe mutton offered yet again this week. The heavy types sold similar at \$180 to \$235 per head, genuine trade types sold at rates of \$135 to \$175 per head light trade selling at \$215 to \$170 with boners selling at \$109 to \$130 with very light types \$75 to \$93
