## Market Comment:

Another small offering at Muchea again this week with a total of 5739 head, Nutrien accounting for 2352 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised of 2025 Lambs, 811 sucker lambs and 2153 ewe mutton.

The front row of our nutrien sale was comprised of mostly old season merino wether lambs in great condition with a good skin, the majority of these heavy weights sold at rates of \$180 to \$220 per head with the very few trade O/S xbl easing slightly. The few heavy weight suckers were sought after by the majority of the trade with the sucker market slightly dearer with heavy types sold at rates of \$192 to \$200, genuine trade sucker lambs also strengthened slightly selling at rates of \$175 to \$185 light trade and feeders also finished slightly stronger.

There was an increase in quality of the ewe mutton offering this week. The heavy types sold similar at rates of \$180 to \$220 per head, Genuine trade types well again at rates of \$135 to \$175 per head with the light trade selling at \$145 to \$170 with boners at Rates of \$105 to \$130 with very light types \$80 to \$95
