## Market Comment:

There were 9652 head offered at Muchea again this week with slight increase over the past few weeks. Nutrien accounted for 3414 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised of 2067 old season Lambs, 1100 sucker lambs and 4734 ewe mutton.

There were very few heavy suckers in our yarding although what was at the front presented well. The majority of these were heavy trade types and sold at rates of \$190 to \$195 per head to remain very similar. Genuine trade sucker lambs also remained similar selling at rates of \$175 to \$185 the light trade and feeders finished slightly stronger on the back of feeder support back into the market place this week. The majority of feeder types sold at rates of \$115 to \$145 per head.

There was an increase in numbers of ewe mutton yarded this week, on the back of this and peak supply out of the paddock, the mutton market suffered up to \$20 per head. Heavy trade types sold at rates of \$160 to \$190 with the genuine trades selling at rates of \$115 to \$145 per head, There was limited grazier support on orange tag and younger ewes. Boners sold at rates of \$90 to \$115 with vey light boners to a low of \$60.
