Market Comment:

It was a very small yarding at Muchea with a lack of quality throughout. Nutrien accounted for 6160 head of the total yarding. The yarding of 6,137 was comprised of 1,848 old season Lambs, 601 sucker lambs and 2584 ewe mutton.

There were very few heavy weight suckers offered throughout the yarding but what was offered remained very similar to sell at rates of \$185 to \$200, Genuine trade sucker lambs sold at rates of \$170 to \$185 with light trade and feeders finishing similar to last week due to continued feeder support with the majority selling at rates of \$115 to \$145 per head.

There were similar numbers of the ewe mutton yarded this week. Heavy trade types sold similar to slightly easier at rates of \$150 to \$200 with the genuine trades selling at rates of \$110 to \$140 per head finishing slightly easier, Boners also sold easier at rates of \$75 to \$105 with very light boners to a low of \$60.
