Market Comment:

A slightly bigger offering this week at Muchea with 7774 head offered in total on the backend of the long weekend with yet again a lack of quality throughout. Nutrien accounted for 2413 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised of 2056 old season Lambs, 787 sucker lambs and 3651 ewe mutton.

There were very few heavy weight suckers offered throughout the yarding. What was available sold at rates of \$185 to \$200. Genuine trade sucker lambs sold at rates of \$170 to \$185 to remain similar, the light trade and feeders finished stronger on the back of increase feeder and grazier support with the majority selling at rates of \$120 to \$150 per head.

There were some bigger lines of ewe mutton yarded this week but did lack quality. Heavy trade types sold slightly easier at rates of \$145 to \$190 with the genuine trades selling at rates of \$110 to \$140 per head finishing slightly easier also, Boners sold slightly dearer with graziers and agents supporting select lines with most selling at rates of \$90 to \$115 with very light boners to a low of \$60 per head.
