## **Market Comment:**

A similar offering this week at Muchea with 7837 head offered in total with an increase in quality throughout. Nutrien accounted for 3757 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised of 1446 old season Lambs, 1971 sucker lambs and 3322 ewe mutton.

There were only a few heavy weight suckers offered within the yarding which sold at rates of \$185 to \$200 per head, genuine trade sucker lambs sold at rates of \$170 to \$185 to remain similar, the light trade and feeders finished firm with continued feeder and grazier support the majority sold at rates of \$120 to \$150 per head.

There were some bigger lines of ewe mutton yarded this week with some great quality offered. Heavy trade types sold similar at rates of \$145 to \$190 with the genuine trades selling at rates of \$110 to \$140 per head finishing similar, boners sold at rates of \$90 to \$115 with very light boners to a low of \$60 per head. Black tag and younger ewes were selected by agents and graziers to sell significantly stronger with the majority of better types \$150 to \$170 with lighter types in that age bracket at \$120 to \$140 per head.
