Market Comment:

A similar offering at Muchea this week with 12,962 head offered in total. Nutrien accounted for 5353 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised of mostly ewe mutton with 4685 head offered while the balance was made up of 1750 sucker lambs and 4388 other grades.

There were a good run of pens of suckers to start the yarding which sold at rates of \$170 to \$180 per head, genuine trade sucker lambs sold at rates of \$170 to \$183 to ease slightly. The light trade and feeders finished very similar with continued feeder and grazier support selling at rates of \$130 to \$150 per head.

There were some big drafts of quality ewe mutton offered this week. Heavy trade types sold easier at rates of \$140 to \$170 with the genuine trades also selling easier at \$100 to \$135 per head finishing easier despite continued grazier support, boners sold at rates of \$90 to \$115 with very light boners to a low of \$70 per head finishing similar to last week. Black tag and younger ewes were selected by agents and graziers to sell slightly stronger in their weight grades selling at rates of \$145 to \$165
