Market Comment:

A smaller offering at Muchea this week with 8446 head offered in total. Nutrien accounted for 2526 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised of mostly ewe mutton with 2998 head offered while the balance was made up of 860 sucker lambs and 4588 Other Grades

There were a several good pens of suckers to start the yarding which sold at rates of \$165 to \$178 per head, Light Trade lambs sold at rates of \$150 to \$160 to finish similar to last week, feeder and store lambs finished very similar with continued support selling at rates of \$115 to \$150 per head.

There were some big drafts of quality ewe mutton offered yet again this week. Heavy trade types sold slightly dearer with more competition from the trade at rates of \$140 to \$195 with the genuine trades also slightly stronger at \$115 to \$135 per headm, Boners sold at rates of \$90 to \$115 with very light boners to a low of \$70 per head finishing similar.
