Market Comment:

7955 head were offered this week at Muchea sheep sale. Nutrien accounted for 3057 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised 963 Sucker lambs, 3269 Ewe Mutton and the balance made up of old season lambs, hoggets and cull rams.

There were a several good pens of suckers to start the yarding which sold at rates of \$165 to \$192 per head, Light Trade lambs sold at rates of \$150 to \$160 to finish similar to last week.

Feeder and store lambs finished slightly easier with limited grazier support again selling at rates of \$85 to \$135 per head.

There were good quality Wheatbelt ewe mutton offered this week. Heavy trade types sold very similar to slightly stronger with continued competition from the trade selling at rates of \$140 to \$185 with the genuine trades also firm at \$115 to \$135 per head with agents selective on several lines pushing the trade buyers to higher rates of \$135 to \$150. Boner mutton sold at rates of \$90 to \$115 with very light boners to a low of \$70 per head finishing similar.
