Market Comment:

7277 Head were offered this week at Muchea sheep sale with the majority of the yarding in store to light trade condition with very few top-quality opportunities presented. Nutrien accounted for 2722 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised 2904 lambs, 3194 Ewe Mutton and the balance made up of predominately large drafts of merino wether hoggets.

There were only a few good pens of suckers on offer which sold at rates of \$155 to \$190 per head to be slightly easier, Light Trade lambs sold at rates of \$135 to \$150 to finish similar to slightly easier last week, feeder and store lambs finished easier with limited grazier and feeder support, quality also lacked with most selling at rates of \$70 to \$130 per head.

There were very few ewe mutton offered this week. Heavy trade types sold very similar to slightly easier selling at rates of \$145 to \$170 with the genuine trades also similar selling at rates of \$115 to \$140 per head. Boner mutton sold at rates of \$88 to \$105 with very light boners to a low of \$70 per head finishing similar.
