## Market Comment:

8552 head were offered this week at Muchea sheep sale with a very mixed quality yarding of small consignments. Nutrien accounted for 4386 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised of 3884 lambs, 3397 ewe mutton and the balance made up of mostly merino wether hoggets and Rams.

There were several good pens of trade lambs that sold at rates of \$155 to \$195 per head remaining similar to last week. Light trade lambs sold at rates of \$138 to \$145 finishing even. Feeder and store lambs followed the even trend selling at rates of \$90 to \$135 per head.

The mutton market this week was fairly flat. Heavy trade types sold at rates of \$135 to \$180, the genuine trades sold at rates of \$100 to \$135 per head. Boner mutton sold at rates of \$75 to \$100 with very light boners to a low of \$30 per head. Selected lines of lighter younger mutton sold slightly stronger due to Agent competition and sold at rates of \$115 to \$150.

Bigger drafts of wether lambs attracted strong competition between graziers and feeders, with the majority selling slightly stronger at rates of \$75 to \$135 and the heavier trade types selling at \$140 to \$170, also pushed by the feeders.
