Market Comment:

6961 head were offered this week at Muchea sheep sale with a very strong quality yarding. Nutrien accounted for 3441 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised of mostly lambs with 4094 head offered, only 1576 head of Ewe Mutton, the balance made up of mostly merino wether hoggets.

The Trade lamb line-up was of exceptional quality this week selling at rates of \$155 to \$211 per head to be fully firm, Light Trade lambs sold at rates of \$138 to \$145 finishing even, the very few feeder and store lambs selling at rates of \$90 to \$135 per head to remain very similar to last week.

Very few mutton were offered this week, Heavy trade types sold at rates of \$140 to \$190, the genuine trades sold at rates of \$105 to \$135 per head. Boner mutton sold at rates of \$75 to \$100 with very light boners to a low of \$60 per head.

Bigger drafts of wethers attracted strong competition between graziers and feeders with the majority selling at rates of \$75 to \$135 with the heavier trade types selling to \$170.
