## Market Comment:

The first sale back at Muchea sheep for the new year saw a reasonable quality yarding across all grades. 10,143 head were offered with Nutrien accounting for 3637 head of the total yarding. The yarding was comprised of mostly lambs with 5392 head offered and 2917 ewe mutton.

The Trade Lamb grades saw a significant increase in local processor competition causing rates to rise upto \$15 per head with the majority selling at \$180 to \$219 per head, Light Trade lambs sold at rates of \$138 to \$145 being similar to where we left off, the feeder and store lambs sold easier at rates of \$80 to \$130 per head.

There were some great drafts of mutton this week with an increase in competition on the top end, Heavy trade types sold at increased rates of \$160 to \$210, the genuine trades sold stronger at rates of \$115 to \$150 per head. Boner mutton sold similar at rates of \$75 to \$100 with very light boners to a low of \$50 per head.
