Market Comment:

This week 14,299 sheep were yarded at the Muchea Livestock Centre, of this Nutrien offered 5902 comprising of 2835 lambs and 3067 sheep.
There were several drafts of well-presented heavy and trade lambs which sold from \$160 to \$239. The majority of lambs yarded were light trade to store types which received strong competition from feedlotter and graziers at rates \$75 to \$125. Heavy mutton was in limited supply which saw values hold. Again younger and lighter types saw good competition between graziers and processors.
