## Market Comment:

Muchea agents yarded 10,178 head this week, Nutrien accounting for 4257 Head with some good quality trade lambs in our front row attracting slightly stronger support, the ewe mutton yarding was also of a good quality but lacked any significant numbers.

There were several good quality drafts of trade lambs available which predominately sold at rates of \$175 to \$220 per head to a top of \$250, finishing slightly stronger on last weeks market, light trade lambs sold at rates of \$140 to \$170 to be similar while feeder and store lambs offered sold at rates of \$70 to \$130 per head

Mutton were once again were short is supply, competition was fully firm with heavy trade types selling at rates of \$155 to \$190 to a top of \$200 per head, the genuine trades sold at rates of \$110 to \$140 per head. Boner mutton also remained similar selling at rates of \$75 to \$110 with very light boners to a low of \$40 per head.
