## Market Comment:

Post long weekend Muchea agents yarded 12411 head, Nutrien accounting for 4686 head with some reasonable quality trade lambs in our front row, the ewe mutton yarding was also of a good quality but lacked any significant numbers. The majority of market grades eased.

There were several good quality drafts of trade lambs available which predominately sold at rates of \$150 to \$180 per head to a top of \$190, finishing significantly easier on last week again. Light trade lambs sold at rates of \$135 to \$152 also easier while feeder and store lambs offered sold predominately at rates of \$70 to \$110 per head.

There were several larger draft of ewe mutton available, competition eased with heavy trade types selling at rates of \$155 to \$190 to a top of \$210 per head for woolly merino ewes. The genuine trades sold at rates of \$110 to \$140 per head also easier. Boner mutton remained similar selling at rates of \$75 to \$110 with very light boners to a low of \$40 per head.
