Market Comment:

An extremely small yarding this week with a mere total of 1,642 head offered making it very hard to accurately quote a market movement but all grades saw healthy local competition from Processors, Agents, Graziers and feeders.

Of the small offering we had one pen of heavy trade lambs which sold for \$182.00 per head. Trade types sold at rates of \$135 to \$150, light trade lambs sold at rates of \$115 to \$130 per head to also finish fully firm, and feeder and store lambs sold at rates of \$60 to \$105 per head.

There were very few pens of mutton offered this week, the heavy trade types sold at rates of \$130 to \$168 per head. The genuine trades sold at rates of \$95 to \$125 per head and the few boner mutton sold at rates of \$50 to \$80.
