Today agents yarded a total of 152 veal with Nutrien livestock selling 119 of them.

Today's numbers increased dramatically with a spread of local and pastoral bred calves and varying weights.

The best bull calves sold up to \$1360 with the steers making \$1250. Demand came from both graziers and butchers.

Droughtmaster Heifers sold to local butchers at a maximum of \$1500.
