

MUCHEA CATTLE REPORT 18th July 2022

Nutrien Livestock reports 1251 cattle sold at Muchea Monday 18th July with Nutrien offering 577 of these. The downward trend from the last sale continues at Muchea with heavy bulls falling 80c/kg to limited competition, due to very tight killing space and staffing issues. A good quality yarding of heavy cows saw values drop 100-110c/kg which flowed on to the medium and lightweight categories. Local yearling steers and heifers were limited in numbers and again competition weak. Good suppliers of young pastoral bulls of good quality eased slightly.
