Market Comment:

A larger yarding this week with Muchea agents offering 3910 head, Nutrien accounted for 1682 head of the total yarding. The yarding mainly consisting of light trade/feeder type lambs with good stores offered and a good line up of mutton also offered.

A similar yarding of lambs to last week's sale with pens of good trade lamb selling from \$150 to \$165 per head, softening on last week. Trade to light trade types also softened to sell at \$135 to \$150. Light trade/feeder lambs sold at rates of \$115 to \$130 whilst feeder and store lambs sold at rates of \$70 to \$95 supported by agents and graziers remaining similar to last week.

A very good line up of 291 mutton was offered this week with competitors returning to the market with demand high. Heavy trade types sold at rates of \$165 to \$192 per head. The genuine trades sold at rates of \$130 to \$160 per head, the few boner mutton sold at rates of \$65 to \$80 with mutton lifting sharply on last week.

Rams this week returning to standard rates of \$70 to \$110
