## **Market Comment:**

A larger yarding this week increasing by 2803 with Muchea agents offering 6713 head, Nutrien accounted for 2472 head of the total yarding.

A very mixed yarding with predominately lighter types in most classes.

A few pens of very heavy lambs sold up to \$159 with limited numbers in most classes. Normal quotes suggested trade lambs back \$5-10 and feeder types back \$5 with stores equal.

Mutton was very similar with limited competition with normal quotes of heavy trade back \$10 and boner types equal.

Nutrien are 4th sale next week.
