Market Comment:

A light yarding this week. Some good drafts of merino ewes and forward store lambs were yarded.

Heavy trade lambs saw a couple of buyers chasing them, pushing prices to top at \$138 for 25kg dresses lambs.

Airfreight lambs were consistent to previous weeks \$105-\$120. Light stores started to attract graziers with values of \$50-\$103.

Drafts of heavy mutton with over 50mm skin sold at values from \$120 to \$140. 18-22kg mutton sold \$100-\$115, plain ewes \$65-\$90.

Rams gained values as the sale progressed topping out at \$110.

Nutrien are 3rd sale next week.
