## **Market Comment:**

Extremely light yarding of 1990 head. 120 new season lambs sold with 1 draft of 36 making \$180 to local butchers. 1250 old season lambs were presented with trade lambs \$110-\$150 for drafts of lambs 23kg+ including 30mm skin, these accounted for 10% of the lambs presented for market.

Airfreight lambs 38-45kg liveweight sold \$70-\$110 and plain condition lambs sold from \$50-\$68.

347 mutton sold with quality varying. Plain condition light ewes selling from \$60-\$85, trade weights \$80-\$100 and ewes 24kg+ dressed with 50mm skin selling to a top of \$125 to average \$110.

Rams were consistent with light rams hoggets \$70-\$110, older mature rams \$110-\$160 depending on condition and skin length.
