Market Comment:

3610 Sheep yarded in Muchea.

2798 Lambs were presented for sale with 40 % being good quality trade lambs.

45-55kg live values were from \$110-\$142.

35-40kg liveweight lambs sold \$90-\$115 with graziers active on 30-35kg lambs selling \$60-\$90.

Only 980 ewes presented for sale. Competition on mutton saw values for trade ewes 18-24kg \$100-\$120 with 30mm skin and lighter ewes sold from \$80-\$100 and very plain averaging \$60.

Ram values for heavy weight \$90-\$120 but most sales \$100 while light rams \$60 average. Ram Lambs suitable for slaughter \$100-\$130 while light weights \$40-\$70.

Nutrien are 1st sale next week.
